Sergeant M.J. Torres joined the Marines in 2004 after graduating from Clearwater High School in Florida. He has done three tours in Iraq, for a total of 18 months and is an aviation operator, overseeing airfield operations. His present responsibilities to the Marine Corp is a recruiter in the Stamford office. Sergeant Torres lives in Shelton with his wife and three children. When his recruitment assignment ends, he will continue his Marine career, possibly in California.

Staff Sergeant Nathanael Avridor
United States Army

Staff Sergeant Nathanael Avridor is a three-tour Iraq war veteran. Since serving in the 2003 invasion, the Stamford native and career soldier has been in Iraq for almost 4 years, living in fatigues, in Humvees or under siege. He was among the first conventional soldiers to enter Baghdad with the 3rd Infantry Division. He became a Staff Sergeant at the age of 24. He first joined the Marines at age 18, then transferred to the Army in 2002.

“9/11” is shorthand for four coordinated terrorist attacks carried out by al Qaeda, an Islamist extremist group, that occurred on the morning of September 11, 2001. The attacks killed 2,976 people; 2,753 people were killed in New York, 184 people were killed at the Pentagon, and 40 people were killed on Flight 93.

We all remember where we were on that fateful morning as the planes flew into the Twin Towers, destroying both towers. We sat by the television or radio, closely following in disbelief the news stories, watching horrified people running down the street, and rescue teams running into the buildings to save lives, only to become victims themselves. Our country was under attack as never before.

Join your BOMA colleagues on September 21st to hear from two service men. They will discuss their thoughts on 9/11 and the United States' involvement overseas. Sergeant M.J.
