Dannel P. Malloy, the youngest of eight children, was born in Stamford, Connecticut, where he still lives. Growing up, Governor Malloy struggled to overcome learning and physical disabilities, eventually learning the skills he needed to succeed. He attended Boston College, where he met his wife, Cathy, and Boston College Law School. Prior to being elected Governor, Malloy was the Mayor of Stamford for 14 years. As Mayor, he brought nearly 5,000 new jobs to the city, led the fight for more affordable housing, championed transportation efforts such as the Stamford Urban Transitway and turned Stamford into one of the 10 best places to live in the country. He also implemented the first city-wide pre-kindergarten program, ensuring all four year olds could attend school, regardless of their parents' financial situation. Governor Malloy began his career as a prosecutor in Brooklyn, serving as an assistant district attorney, where he won 22 convictions in 23 felony cases. Returning home to Stamford, Connecticut, he served on the Boards of Finance and Education before running for Mayor.
